Late May–Mid June

Extra Aardvark Israel programming in Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, and throughout Israel.

Mid June

Fly to Uganda, and move into the TEN Center.

Weekly Schedule

Monday–Thursday

8:00–9:00: Breakfast and prepare for the field

9:00–13:00: Morning volunteering. Volunteers will assist in local primary schools, helping with arts and crafts and English tutoring.

13:00–14:00: Lunch and break

14:00–17:00: Afternoon volunteering. Volunteers will create activities and games in local community centers, for children of all ages. Activities will focus on sustainability, critical thinking, and problem solving.

19:00: Dinner

20:00–21:30: Evening activities. Evenings will rotate between International Development Sessions on poverty, social justice, environment, etc.; Educational Method Sessions on cross-cultural learning, as well as technical tools for teaching; and Free Evenings for volunteers to explore on their own.

Fridays and Saturdays alternate between community Shabbat at the TEN Center and free weekends to explore on your own.
